



Flamboree Joining Fee

Flamboree is an international camp, gathering scouts and guides from all over the world. Of course, this requires a major organization compared to an ordinary annual scout camp. So, it implies also a higher joining fee. Question to be answered: what do you get for this €210?

The organization takes care you wouldn't feel bored since we offer a broad range of activities. The camp will start and end with an marvelous show and in between, you're offered a fantastic mass party. You'll also go on a journey to a Belgian city, join Waterworld and outdoor activities and we even send you back in time! Apart from these off-site activities, there's a lot to be explored on the camp site as well: scouting skills, sports and games, GPS, showbiz and fashion in Scouting... it's only a small selection of the activities awaiting you. In the evening, your subcamp awakes, presenting you their own program. You can join dinner with the neighbor African troop, challenge an Austrian to a chess battle, sing songs at the campfire pit or just enjoy the evening program the subcamp staff has to offer. The international dimension makes Flamboree a once-in-a-lifetime experience.

The fee also covers accommodation, usage of sanitary provisions and meals. We make sure you have plenty of pioneering wood to turn your troop ground into a real temporary home. At arrival, you're given a welcome packet containing a camp license, scarf and badge. Every day, a new edition of the Flamborean newspaper is worked out, providing you with the latest news. This way, the Kluis is turned into a tiny village of 1500 people.

However, some things you'll need to provide yourself. For example, transport from and to the camp site is not included in the fee, although we offer transport from/to the airport or railway station to foreign groups paying an additional cost. We're also expecting Belgian groups to bring their own cookery equipment and sleeping tents.

During the camp, various things are offered for sale. There will be a café where everyone can enjoy a snack or drink during the day. Drinkable water is always available for free. Of course, the shop offers exclusive Flamborean shirts and gadgets. All this requires a little pocket money.

Joining fee for staff amounts to €150. The lower cost can be explained by the fact they're expected to devote themselves actively to the guiding of this Flamborean adventure. They will perform tasks such as activities guidance, subcamp staff, logistics and administration. They can also join the erecting or breaking down of the campsite without additional paying.

Insurance

Participants of 'Scouts en Gidsen Vlaanderen' are automatically insured by the ordinary members polis. It isn't necessary to make an additional insurance against physical accidents or civil liability.



Foreign participants should have an insurance securing against personal physical accidents, repatriation and civil liability. Further, everyone is responsible for his personal luggage, the organization cannot be held responsible in case of loss, theft or damage. We advice to take an additional insurance for expensive goods you bring along yourself.

In case of troubles when attempting to insure against personal physical accidents, repatriation and civil liability in their own country, foreigners can always contact finances@flamboree.be for help. An extra cost could possibly be counted.

Weighted fee

The camp fee shouldn't cause problems to participants having financial troubles. They can get a reduced camp fee, if they match the weighted requirements. More information can be achieved via finances@flamboree.be.
